

Rules and Regulations – to be read in conjunction with The Rod Fishing Byelaws 2015, Natural Resources Wales available at <http://naturalresources.wales> (hard copy available on request)

1. Salmon fishing bait must not be less than 5cms. All salmon caught between 3<sup>rd</sup> March and 15<sup>th</sup> June must be released.
2. No worming except in spate conditions and only between 15<sup>th</sup> April and 30<sup>th</sup> September subject to method restriction dates below.
3. No stationary worming. Fishermen using such bait must move along the bank unless disabled.
4. No club or competitive angling at any time.
5. **No spinning for trout.** Any trout caught whilst spinning for salmon must be returned to the water.
6. No wading before March 20<sup>th</sup>.
7. No fishing other than fly until April 15<sup>th</sup>.
8. No fishing other than as stated in open seasons and method restrictions as set out in box 14 below and in these rules and regulations.
9. The Management Committee has imposed a bag limit of two trout and one salmon in a 24 hour period.
10. No lead weights.
11. All waste nylon filament to be removed.
12. No fishing except fair rod and line, no night line or night lobworm allowed and no fishing with maggots.
13. It is illegal to take fish not reaching the following size limits measured from tip of snout to the fork of the tail: sea or brown trout – 23cm; salmon – 30cm.
14. Tickets are not transferable. Any ticket holder lending his/her ticket shall be disqualified from fishing.
