

Rules and Regulations

To be read in conjunction with The Rod Fishing Byelaws, Natural Resources Wales available at <http://naturalresources.wales> (hard copy available on request)

1. Salmon Fishing

- a) Season: 3rd March to 17th October.
- b) Fly only 3rd March until 1st June.
- c) Fly and spinner from 1st June until 17th October.
- d) Spinning baits for salmon must not be less than 5cm in length.
- e) No maggot permitted.
- f) All salmon caught must be returned alive and unharmed as quickly as possible. (NRW Bylaw)

2. Brown Trout Fishing

- a) Season: 3rd March to 30th September
- b) Fly only. (Any brown trout caught whilst spinning for salmon must be returned to the water).
- c) The Management Committee has imposed a bag limit of two brown trout in a 24 hour period. No brown trout less than 23cm to be taken (measured from tip of snout to the fork of the tail).

3. Sea Trout Fishing

- a) Season: 20th March to 17th October
- b) Spinning permitted from 1st April to 17th October.
- c) Single worm for sea trout restricted to day-time spate conditions and from 1st June to 15th September.
- d) No maggots permitted.
- e) No stationary worming. Fishermen using such bait must move along the bank unless disabled.
- f) Night fishing for sea trout by fly only.
- g) Sea trout below 23cm (measured from tip of snout to fork of tail), or above 60cm, to be returned alive and unharmed without delay.
- h) The Management Committee has imposed a bag limit of two sea trout in a 24 hour period.

4. No club or competitive angling at any time, unless with prior permission.

5. No fishing other than that stated in open seasons and method restrictions as set out in these rules and regulations.

6. No lead weights.

7. All waste nylon filament to be removed.

8. Fishing at all times with fair rod and line only and according to NRW bye-laws. No night lines, use of maggots, snatching or other excluded methods.

9. Tickets are not transferable. Any ticket holder lending his/her ticket shall be disqualified from fishing.

10. Hooks for salmon and sea trout to comply with latest Natural Resources Wales bye-laws. Please check the NRW latest edition bye-laws booklet (see above) before you go fishing as changes may have occurred since our information was last updated. NRW bye-laws take precedence over local rules.

11. Maps detailing the fishing grounds are available from ticket vendor.
